Notice to competitors

Important please read this information

Competitors, through the submission of the entry, acknowledge that they know the AAC rules and regulations. Each competitor takes part in this event at their own risk. The release form must be signed to meet the registration requirements of the AAC. The organizing committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

All obstacles will conform to the AAC specifications. Note that three (e) electronic timers will be used . À noter que trois (3) chronomètres électroniques seront utilisés dans les rings. This competition will take place in a soccer stadium on a Astro Turf surface. Certain obstacles will be covered with rubber and will be used in the standard ring along with a break away tire.

All dogs must be registered individually with the AAC in order to participate in the Québec Provincial Agility . The competition is open to all dogs 18 months of age or over, whether purebred or not. Dogs in heat, dogs suffering from an injury and dogs that show aggression toward people or other dogs will not be allowed. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when called into the ring or when you are warming up your dog in the area provided for this purpose.

It is understood that competitors have the sole responsibility for the behavior of the dogs. A competitor whose dog is a nuisance or whose behavior is dangerous may, at the discretion of the organizing committee, be asked to leave the site, without refund. This regulation will be strictly enforced. Discipline cases will be forwarded to the AAC Discipline Committee for consideration.

We urge you to show respect towards our volunteers and the facilities. The organizing committee reserves the right to take all the appropriate measures.

To have everything run smoothly during the competition, each competitor must respect the running order. To do so, he must make his presence known at least 3 dogs in advance before his run. Competitors who do not comply with this regulation will lose their turn and not be refunded.

Admission criteria

All AAC identity cards must signed confirming the height of the dog. Otherwise, dogs can be measured by one of the judges for this competition only. The competitor must then compete with his dog at the height established or higher, if available.

Residents of another province or the United States may participate in the Québec Provincial Agility, only if they have obtained the permission from the AAC committee.

The Québec Provincial Agility is open to all competitors whose dog have mastered agility and have the physical and mental abilities necessary to participate. All competitors whose dog is eligible to enter an approved AAC trial are invited to participate in their Provincial Agility.

The Provincial Agility is composed of six events, two standards, two gamblers and two jumpers. Dogs must participate in all six events to be eligible for a placement rosette of the Québec Provincial Agility. The events will be judges according to expert rules modified. No titles and/or qualifiers will be awarded for the Québec Provincial Agility. To qualify for the National Championship, a dog must have participated in all six events and obtained a total of 350 points or more. A person may enter more than one dog, but a dog cannot be handled by more than one person.

Entry fees

Entry fees for the (6) events of the Québec Provincial Agility is \$110.00. Entries must be accompanied with the full payment in order to be valid. Not entry will be accepted by email. Additional fees will be charged for all cheques that have not been honored. All fees are payable in Canadian dollars. Cheques post-dated after the closing date (May 22nd 2013) will be refused.

There will be no refunds for entries canceled after the closing date or in the event that the competitor or dog does not show, is removed or expelled by the organizing committee responsible of the competition, a judge or a veterinary. The owner of a dog that comes into heat or a dog that is injured will be partially reimbursed provided they notify the secretary at least 48hrs before the day of the competition and present a certificate from a veterinary. In these cases, **an administrative fee of 15% will be retained.**

A confirmation will be sent to all participants as soon as possible after the closing day. Each participant is responsible in promptly informing the secretary of any mistakes found in their confirmation.
